

NDBRA Exam Guidelines- Mar. 2018

(Note: New language is in bold)

Guidelines & Procedures

All Active and Provisional members are required to submit and pass **theory exam(s) as prescribed by the Executive.**

Inactive members returning during the season will be required to submit and pass the exams provided by the Exam Chair.

All members will be required to submit or complete the exam requirements in the time lines established by the Executive. Failure to do so may result in the curtailment of games, loss of good standing or suspension.

The onus is on the member writing the exam to contact the Exam Chair to obtain exam(s); failure to submit completed exam(s) will result in fines and other Penalties as outlined below. Should a member have extenuating circumstances where the exam can not be submitted on time, it is the member's responsibility to contact the Exam Chair in advance to request an extension to exam due date. Requests will be accepted/rejected by Exam Chair.

Definitions

1. Very Controlled Conditions – Exams supervised, no discussion, no books or materials.
2. Controlled Conditions – Exam supervised, no discussion, open book
3. Take Home – Open book. Exams must be returned to an Exam Chair or Committee member by deadline established by Executive.

Theory Exams

FIBA Rules 1 (Optional as per the Executive)

- Type of Exam: **Rules exam provided at the September General Meeting**
- Conditions: Take Home
- Due Date: As set by NDBRA Executive
- Passing Grade: Level 1 – 70%, Level 2 – 80%, Level 3,4,5 – 86%

FIBA Rules 2

Type of Exam: CABO National Exam **on FIBA rules, IAABO FIBA Exam**

Conditions: On-Line as set by CABO **or Proctored through the NDBRA**

Due Date: As set by CABO **or NDBRA**

Passing Grade: Level 1 – 70%, Level 2 – 80%, Level 3 – 86%, Level 4 administered by CABO, Level 5 administered by FIBA.

IAABO Applicants

IAABO applicants must write on the first Monday of November under very controlled conditions and achieve the IAABO standard of 86%. If applicants score between 74% and 84% the applicant may be permitted to take the practical floor test and if they pass that, they may attempt a 2nd theory exam later in the same season (early March at the latest).

Penalties & Fines

- \$20 fine for **FIBA Rules 1** Exam not submitted or not submitted by due date as outlined above
- **FIBA Rules 2 Exam not completed – Immediate suspension**
- **Suspension will terminate upon receipt of the following Sept. take home exam.**
- Failure to attain theory exam standards as indicated above **may** require the member to take a remake exam **or** locating and noting rules references for each question answered incorrectly. Member's games may be curtailed until this is completed.
- **Remakes or References are to be submitted within 14 days of receipt of notification or game assignments will be curtailed.**
