Selection Criteria for Provincial/National Appointments

Provincial Appointments:

- member in good standing with NDBRA
 - regular attendance at meetings and clinics
 - consistently adheres to timelines (fees, exams, etc.)
 - consistently accepts game assignments and carries out these Assignments responsibly
- member in good standing with IAABO
- consistently demonstrates a keen interest and commitment to furthering Officiating experiences (outside seminars and/or camps)
- displays good knowledge of officiating through consistently achieving above 85% on exams
- recent floor test evaluation indicating high quality officiating
- active and current game experience in “**high caliber**” ball - semi-final of any of the major tournaments and/or Zone, SOSSA playoff games
- actively officiating at the level of the appointment
- availability – able to commit 100% to the appointment – all meetings and any game assignments
- able to meet the physical requirements of the appointment

National Appointments:

- all of the above
- displays good knowledge of FIBA rules through obtaining above 86% or greater on exams
- at least “one” previous Provincial appointment
- must have the qualifications/experience set down by the various governing Associations

Criteria for Committee Membership

- non-candidate for National & Provincial tournaments
- several years of experience in basketball officiating
- hold IAABO membership
- achieved a high level of officiating
- have respect of the membership
- have a high degree of basketball knowledge
- no conflict of interest as per Constitution Art.VII Sec.2 #8
