PROCEDURE FOR GAME REPORTS involving Verbal and/or Physical Abuse of Officials

1. Any incident involving verbal or physical abuse of officials, flagrant technical or personal fouls and/or unsportsmanlike conduct of players, coaches or fans must be verbally reported the same day to the President.
2. The President then will advise the official if a written report is required.
3. Follow-up by the President to the Interpreter, Assigning Officer and Secretary is mandatory.
4. Item to be dealt with immediately as required or tabled until the next Executive Meeting where the participating officials will be invited to attend.

PROCEDURE IF PARTNER IS INJURED

1. If an official is injured seriously, no attempt to move the official should be made.
2. An ambulance should be called if necessary. Dial 911.
3. Spouse or parents should be notified. Each official should carry with him/her a phone number at which a relative or friend could be reached.
4. When the injured official is looked after, the other official may continue to officiate the game if both coaches agree.
5. If an official is injured as a result of an attack by a player, coach, substitute, team attendant or follower, the team to which the attacker belongs must forfeit the game immediately.
6. Any league using a gymnasium should have access to a phone in case of emergency.
